Doris is one of many babies born at Christian Hospital in "Overtown" Miami. She lived on 15th Street and 5th Av across from Mr. Sam's Store. If you attended Dunbar Elementary School, you may vaguely remember that for approximately one week a little girl came in the school screaming to get out, her Mom having to assist the teacher to settle her down. After a week of this, she had to walk to school with her Mom a block behind with a switch. That little girl was Doris, who finally learned to enjoy going to school.

During our High School years, Doris was part of a singing group "The Quivettes", composed of Yvonne and Kathy Jones (sisters of Jesse & Melton Jones), Luvenia McMath and Doris. Mr. Jesse Jones, Sr. was our manager. The Quivettes sang at major Hotels and Clubs on Miami Beach and traveled from Key West to Tallahassee and in between for about 2 1/2 years. We believe they were the first, and youngest, Black group of girls to sing in the grand hotels on Miami Bench. If only it was recorded in history. The group name was eventually changed to the "Luvs".
